Motorsport Ireland held a meeting with the affiliated Clubs on 7th August 2021 at which a number of initiatives were announced to give the competitors a greater involvement in the administration of our sport. MSC Commissions

As members of the Motor Enthusiasts' Club you are invited to put forward a nomination for a position on any of the Motorsport Commissions which, have in the past, been nominated by the MSC. The person proposed must accept the proposal. A list of the Commissions and number of MSC seats can be found in Appendix 101 of the Yearbook. The criteria for nomination is:

- Proposed by another individual, who must accept the proposal.
- Motorsport CV attached.
- Be a member of an affiliated club for the previous three years.

A nominations committee will be formed by the MSC to check the compliance of the nominations and select most suitable individuals if over subscribed.

Competitors Commission

A Competitors Commission chaired by rally driver Donagh Kelly will be created to give a voice to competitors across ALL disciplines. The criteria for membership is:

- One nomination per club.
- Nominee must be a current Motorsport Ireland licence holder.

• Nominee must have competed in at least two events per year in the previous three years but due to Covid they will initially use 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Competitors Consultation Panel

A competitors consultation panel will be created for each discipline with in the sport. This panel is being created so that specialist commissions can consult with current competitors in that discipline regarding upcoming rule changes. The criteria for membership is:

- Self-nomination by a competitor.
- They must be a current Motorsport Ireland licence holder.

• Have competed in at least two events per year of the discipline that the competitor is nominating themselves for in the previous three years due to Covid they will use initially 2017, 2018 and 2019.

• The names for the panel will be drawn randomly at a clubs meeting.

Note we can only make one nomination to the Competitors Commission so any additional information supporting your case would be of benefit to the Club in selecting an individual to nominate.
