<u>Double Drives:</u>	There may be only one number visible on each side of the competing car when it enters the start area. The onus is on the driver to make sure the correct number is on display at all times.

ENTRY FEES:	€140 per single day or €245 two days.		
Competition Licence:	Minimum of National B Speed Licence is required with the exception of competitors competing in classes 3A, 3B, 3C, 6, 7, 9 and 10 which are required to have a minimum of a National A Speed licence. <u>ALL CARS OVER 1650 cc require a National A Speed Licence, irrespective of class.</u>		
<u>Scrutiny</u> :	Scrutiny will be between 7.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. on both days.		
<b>Briefing</b> :	9.15 a.m. both days. Drivers should walk the road before drivers briefing		
<u>Start:</u>	Start will be 10.00 a.m. on both days.		
<u>Awards:</u>	Trophies will be presented to 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> overall and 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> in each class on both days. The Telford Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner with the fastest cumulative time for the two days.		
Prizegiving:	Saturday and Sunday prize giving will be held in the paddock immediately after the event.		
<u>General:</u>	The onus is on the competitors to present themselves at the start line for each run. Failure to be on the line in good time will result in the competitor missing the run. Those wishing to double drive must identify themselves to the Secretary prior to sign-on. Double drivers must adhere strictly to the conditions notified at drivers briefing. The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to apply penalties as per GCR's.		
<u>Noise:</u>	Competitors must not rev engines before 9:00am or after racing finishes. All cars competing must comply with the 105db or 108db noise limit as applicable depending on class. Noise levels will be continually monitored during the day.

**1A Production/Modified Production Saloons** up to 1400 cc, Roadsters up to 1400 cc, Rally Cars up to 1650 cc with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.

1B Fiat Cinquecento/Seicento as per Technical Regulations published on the MI website.

2 Production/Modified Production saloons 1401-1650 cc, Roadsters 1401-1650 cc.

**3A Production/Modified Production Saloons** 1651-2100 cc, Roadsters 1651-2100 cc, Front engine Sports cars up to 1650 cc (car derived engines), Front engine Sports cars up to 1200 cc (motorbike derived engine), Silhouette cars up to 1650 cc, Space-framed saloons up to 1650 cc.

**3B Production/Modified Production Saloons** over 2100 cc. Roadsters over 2100 cc, Silhouette cars from 1651-2100 cc, Space-framed saloons over 1650 cc, Front engine Sports cars with bike derived engines over 1200 cc, Front engined Sports cars with car derived engines 1651-2100 cc, 4WD Production saloons/modified saloons.

**3C Silhouette cars** over 2100 cc, Rear engined Sports cars up to 2100 cc, Front engine Sports cars with car derived engines over 2100 cc, Alloy & composite saloons unlimited.

4 Classic cars as per HRCA regulations (reference MI appendix 49 and FIA Appendix K).

Compliance documents required: HTP, HRVIF, or written confirmation of compliance with the HRCA regulations from an authorised representative of the HRCA.

**5 Formula Ford 1600/Classic Formula Ford 1600** as per current or previous Ford Motorsport regulations. Formula Vee as per current or previous Formula Vee regulations (Appendix 45).

It is permitted to use the current Avon tyres in lieu of the Dunlop Tyres specified in previous regulations.

**6 Single seaters** up to 2100 cc having only 2 valves per cylinder, Single seaters up to 1650 cc having more than 2 valves per cylinder.

7 Single seaters over 2100 cc having only 2 valves per cylinder, Single seaters over 1650 cc having more than 2 valves per cylinder, Rear engined Sports cars over 2100 cc 4WD cars (to cover any 4WD vehicle that is not rally/Production/Modified Production saloon).

**8** Rally cars up to 1650 cc with more than 2 valves per cylinder, Rally cars up to 2100 cc with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.

**9 Rally cars** 1651cc –2100 cc with more than 2 valves per cylinder, Rally cars 2101–3000 cc with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.

**10 Rally cars** over 2100 cc with more than 2 valves per cylinder, Rally cars over 3000 cc with not more than 2 valves per cylinder, All 4WD rally cars.
