START AT 11.00 AM. DRIVERS BRIEFING AT 10.45 AM.

Competitors are requested to arrive at least 45 minutes before start time (10.15am).

A penalty of five marks may be imposed on Competitors who fail to enter the section in the draw sequence.

CAR/TYRES; MARKS; CREW

as laid down in Motorsport Ireland regulations for Sporting Trials in 2020 Yearbook.

No competition car may be driven on any part of the course or adjoining lands by any person other than a person who has entered for the event and who has signed the official entry form.

TIES as laid down in Motorsport Ireland regulations for Sporting Trials in 2020 Yearbook.

IMPORTANT

for insurance reasons, no competing car may carry more than two persons during the event or whilst the car is in any part of the course or adjoining lands. All such persons carried must be either an entered driver, an entered passenger or bouncer, or an official of the meeting. No other person is permitted in the car.

No wheeled vehicle other than those competing are allowed on any part of the course or adjoining lands.

VERBAL ABUSE of an OBSERVER may result in an additional 10 point penalty as per GCRs 139.7 and 142.3
Competitors are NOT permitted to ALTER the COURSE (Appendix 88, 4.8). Breach will incur 10 point penalty.

COMPETITION LICENCES

All Competitors must hold a valid Competition Licence in accordance with Appendix 1 of the 2020 Yearbook.

A Clubman National B Licence is available to Competitors over 16 years. A Junior Licence is available to Competitors aged 14-16 years. 10 to 13 year olds must be in possession of a COVER NOTE issued by MI.

JUNIOR ENTRIES

Competitors aged 10 to 16 inclusive may enter for the event. Junior competitors must be accompanied in the car by a holder of a Competition Licence of a grade no lower than Clubman National B, at all times, except for 14 to 16 year olds, who may drive unaccompanied when competing in an observed section. 10 to 13 year olds will only compete to the 5 mark and must wear the bib provided and a restraining strap at all times while driving.

AWARDS Subject to ongoing Covid-19 restrictions, awards will be made available at the venue.

MEC Sporting Trial 17/10/20 – FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

The safety of our Officials and Competitors is paramount so in order to provide the best possible protection the following changes to the running of the event will apply. There is NO exception to these rules.

ENTRIES

- Entries will only be accepted on line at www.mec.ie (preferably) or by post.
- All entries must be paid in advance. No money will change hands at event. If you enter and can't start we will refund entry fee in full. Please telephone or text the secretary (087 2574406) if entered and not starting.
- Entries must be received by the closing date, NO LATE, TELEPHONE OR EMAIL ENTRIES.
- One day licences should be ordered and paid for with entry.
- Download from MEC website and complete the '**Competitors Pre-Event Declaration**' form and submit 3 days (**and only 3 days**) before the event. Email to roystewart@mec.ie and bring original to event.

If you are showing any of the following symptoms, please do not travel to the event:

- A fever – high temperature – 38 degrees Celsius or above.
- A cough – this can be any kind of cough, not just dry.
- Shortness of breath or breathing difficulties
- Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

ARRIVAL AT VENUE

- You will have your temperature checked. If you are over the designated limit (38°) you must leave immediately, your entry fee will be refunded.
- Leave your completed 'Competitor Pre-Event Declaration' in the box provided.
- No spectators will be permitted to enter the venue. Please do not bring non-competitors with you.
- Hand sanitisers will be provided on site. Nonetheless we recommend that you bring your own.

CHECK-IN - Competitors

- No tickets will be handed out, observers will record score on master sheet.
- Online entries are not required to sign indemnity as it is included in the Competitor Pre-event Declaration.
- Competitors who have purchased a One Day licence should see the event secretary.
- Starting order will be published on secretary's car as normal.

CHECK-IN – Officials/Observers

- Officials and Observers, complete the **Officials & Marshals sign on and Pre Event Declaration** and email to roystewart@mec.ie 3 days (**and only 3 days**) before the event. There is no further sign on. Please bring original to event and leave in box provided.
- Observers will receive folder containing Master Sheet and Starting Order. **Pencil** will be provided but we recommend you bring your own. Note a pencil works better if it is wet.

COVID-19

EVENT

- There will be a drivers briefing respecting Covid guidelines and social distancing.
- Following the briefing, competitors should go to their designated start section for the start time (11am).
- The start time of the second lap will be announced at the briefing.
- Passengers may be carried in competing cars in accordance with Appendix 88. Both driver and passenger MUST wear a mask when in the car together.
- As far as possible, social distancing should be observed, particularly when walking sections.
- When signaled to start section by observer, drive the section as usual.
- At the end of the section the observer will verbally advise you of your score and record it on the master sheet. You can take note of your score for your own records. Master sheet will take precedence.
- After completing the event please do not congregate in groups.

RESULTS

- Subject to Covid guidelines, provisional results will be announced at the venue and posted on the Club website not later than 7pm. They will be deemed final at 8pm on day of event unless there is a query or protest.
- Again subject to Covid guidelines and maintaining social distancing, awards will be made available at the venue.
- Any queries must be received by email to roystewart@mec.ie not later than 8pm on day of event. If as a consequence of the query the results are changed, revised provisional results will be posted for a period of 24 hours after which they will be deemed final.
- All Protests must be submitted in accordance with GCR160, emailed to roystewart@mec.ie and followed by a phone call to 087 2574406 to provide credit card details for the protest fee before 8pm on the date of the event. Protest hearings may be conducted by electronic means. Protest forms can be downloaded from the MI website.
