Declaration by all Signatories

I declare that:

1) I have been given the opportunity to read the General Regulations of Motorsport Ireland ('General Regulations') and, if any, the Supplementary Regulations for this Event and agree to be bound by them. I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the Event and I am competent to do so. I acknowledge the potential risks inherent with motor sport and accept that these risks may give rise to my suffering personal injury or other loss.

1(a)) I am not currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 and have not been in contact with anyone showing symptoms within the last 14 days, If after submitting this form I do come into contact with someone with COVID-19 or if I start to exhibit any of the signs indicating that I may be infected I will immediately withdraw from the Event, notify the club running and Motorsport Ireland and ensure that my close contacts also do not attend. Should I become ill at or start to exhibit COVID-19 symptoms at the Event I shall withdraw safely and notify the Secretary of the Meeting by telephone / SMS accordingly including identification of those others who I have come into contact with at the Event.

1(b)) I agree to abide by all Government, HSE and Motorsport Ireland requirements imposed in respect of COVID-19. I understand that Motorsport Ireland Guidance on COVID-19 in relation to Events has Regulatory status and shall supersede all other rules and regulations. I understand that a breach of my obligations within this document may lead to being disqualified from the Event and heavy additional penalties.

To the best of my belief the driver(s) possess(es) the standard of competence necessary for the Event to which this entry relates and that the vehicle entered conforms to the Regulations of the Event. Where applicable the use of the vehicle hereby entered will be covered by insurance as required by law.

I agree that should I at the time of this Event be suffering from any disability whether permanent or temporary which is likely to affect prejudicially my normal control of the vehicle, I may not take part unless I have declared such disability to Motorsport Ireland which has, following such declaration, issued a licence which permits me to do so. I undertake that at the time of the Event to which this entry relates I shall have passed or am exempt from an ASN specified medical examination within the specified period.

If I am the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor of the driver I have countersigned the competitor licence application and understand that I shall have the right to be present during any procedure being carried out under the Event Supplementary Regulations and the General Regulations and that I have acquainted myself and the minor with them, agree to pay any appropriate charges and fees pursuant to those Regulations and agree to be bound by and submit myself without reserve to the consequences resulting from them (and any alteration thereof). Further, I agree to pay any liquidated damages any fines imposed upon me up to the maxima set out in the event guidelines.

Note: Where the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor will not be present the Parent/Guardian/Guarantor must advise the organisers in advance, in writing, authorising their appointed representative to so act.

I hereby agree to abide by all applicable Motorsport Ireland Policies and Guidelines including but not exclusively Safeguarding and Anti Alcohol and Drugs policies and the National Sporting Code of Conduct.

I have read and shall respect the regulations for Control of Drugs and Alcohol as contained in the General rules and regulations and have also fully familiarised myself with the information on the web sites referred to (www.motorsportireland.com and www.wada-ama.org) in particular the Sport Ireland Anti-Doping Rules which have been adopted by Motorsport Ireland. Further, if I am counter signing as the parent or Guardian of a minor then in addition to the deemed consent to the testing of that minor. I hereby confirm that I give such consent for the minor concerned to be so tested.

I understand and agree that my personal data is being processed solely for the purposes of running this Event and may be used for the purposes of COVID-19 infection tracing, and will be handled by the organisers in accordance with Motorsport Ireland data protection policy: www.motorsportireland.com/data-protection.

I confirm I will bring all required documentation, licences etc., to the Event as usual and I understand that spot checks will be made with regard to documentation and technical checks.

RISK WARNING, DISCLAIMER, AND INDEMNITY

I understand that Motor Sport is a dangerous recreational activity and there is at all times a significant risk of injury, disability or death. I acknowledge that the risks associated with attending or participating in Motor Sport include but are NOT LIMITED to the risk that I may suffer harm as a result of motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles or persons or property; other participants acting dangerously or with lack of skills; high levels of noise exposure; acts of violence and other harmful acts (whether intentionally or inadvertently) committed by persons attending or participating in the event; and the failure or unsuitability of facilities to ensure my safety.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by Motorsport Ireland I agree that neither any one of or any combination of Motorsport Ireland and its associated clubs, the organisers, the track owners or other occupiers, the promoters and their respective officers, servants, representatives and agents (collectively known as 'The Parties') shall have any liability for loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me as a result of participation in the event including but not limited to damage to property, economic loss, consequential loss or financial loss howsoever caused.

To the fullest extent permitted by law I agree to indemnify and hold harmless each of The Parties in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever and howsoever arising from my participation in this Event.

Furthermore, in exchange for being able to attend or participate in the Event, I agree to release Motorsport Ireland from all liability for:

- a) my death.
- b) any physical or mental injury (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury);
- c) the contraction, aggravation, or acceleration of a disease.
- d) the coming into existence, the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of any other condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behaviour, course of conduct or state of affairs that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community or that may result in

harm or disadvantage to me or the community, howsoever arising from my participation in or attendance at the Event; to indemnify and hold harmless and keep indemnified Motorsport Ireland to the maximum extent permitted by law in respect of any Claim by any person; and to attend at or participate in the Event **at my own risk entirely**.

I understand that:

- nothing in this document excludes, restricts, or modifies any statutory rights that I may have.
- nothing in this document prevents Motorsport Ireland from relying on any laws (including statute and common law) that limit or preclude their liability.

EVENT INDEMNITY

a) I have read the supplementary regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules and Regulations of MI including the guidelines and regulations contained in Motorsport Ireland's Code of Conduct for Children's Sport. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Motor Enthusiasts' Club, Company Limited by Guarrantee, Irish Automobile Club Ltd. t/a Royal Irish Automobile Club, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd. t/a Motorsport Ireland and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in the event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this Agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses, and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).

(e) Any indemnity and/or declaration as prescribed by sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) above which is signed by a person under the age of 18 years shall be countersigned by that person's parent or guardian, whose full names and address shall be given. Furthermore, the parents and/or guardians of persons under 18 years of age shall grant permission to MI and the Irish Sports Council to carry out tests in accordance with the Irish Anti-Doping Rules (Rule No 139) in the following form:
